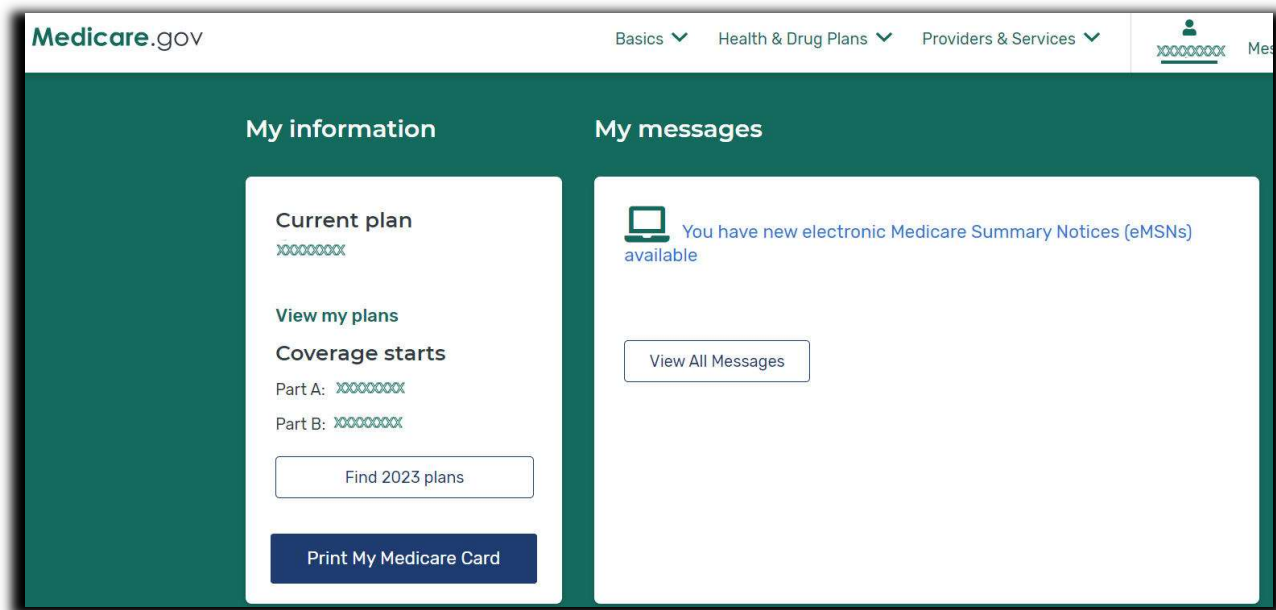

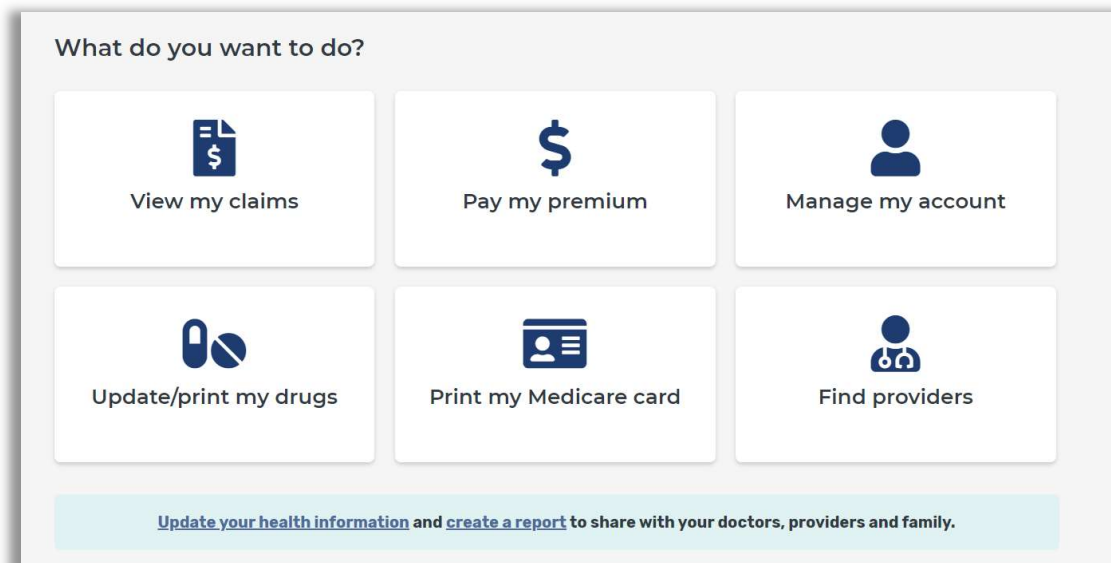
Log In.

You will see the top of the first page. That page will include basic information about your Medicare account.




Scroll down the page to see
